### **8.19 (ICR) Breast Screen NSW - Breast Screen Van Visit to Parkes**

#### **Executive Summary**

Breast Screen NSW advises that the breast screen van will visit Parkes from 8 to 21 November 2005. The organisers request that Council provide assistance as it has done in the past by relocating the van from the site of its Forbes promotion to Parkes prior to the commencement of screenings.

#### **Background Information**

It has been sometime since the breast screen van has visited Parkes. It is very well received by the community when a promotion is conducted in the Parkes area and Council has offered its assistance previously in ensuring that the van is located in a suitable position in town to maximise the campaign. Council did agree to use its prime mover to tow the self contained van from Forbes prior to the last visit which ensured a smooth integration into the Parkes community for this much needed health promotion. The location for the van will be the M & D carpark adjacent to the Little Theatre.

Minimal costs associated with internal plant hire for the use of Council's prime mover.
