Development Application Information

Proposal: Upgrading of Lighting Facility

Executive Summary

A modification application has been received from Mr Chris Martin from the Parkes Touch Association Inc. The application is to modify Condition 4 of Development Consent No.DA06081 to allow the operation of lights at Cheney Park for a period prior to obtaining certification that the lights fully comply with Australian Standard AS/NZS 4282 - 1997 'Control of the Obtrusive Effects of Outdoor Lighting'.

Recommendation

It is recommended that Condition No.4 of Development Consent No.DA06081 be modified to read:

All lighting shall be designed and installed so that minimal light will be cast onto any adjoining property. Lighting shall not cause a nuisance or be objectionable to the travelling public on the nearby roadways. In this regard the applicant shall submit to Council written confirmation from a suitably qualified professional that the lighting satisfies the above requirements and Australian Standard AS/NZS 4282 - 1997 'Control of the Obtrusive Effects of Outdoor Lighting', no later than 15 June 2007.
