



The Loop Walk around the lake;

The pathway, would allow users to experience the different planting zones and water species, while also providing areas for shaded refuge and relaxation on strategically placed benches with beautiful views across the water and islands.

Proposed Adventure Play Areas



The Adventure Playground

The masterplan proposes to develop a unique Adventure Play Area in addition to and seperate from the exsting playground infrastructure. This type of play area could be themed and would certainly provide the community with an area of play that would inspire kids to use their imagination during play time. The elements and areas would cater for multiple age groups (likely up to age 10) and provide opportunities for immersive play, allow children to develop their creativy, refine their moterskills, build their own obstacles, challenge their thinking and encourage communal play for longer periods of time. Item's and materials like ropes, logs, sand, mud, large boulders, tunnels, recycled materials and elements would all be part of this area.

Existing Playground Extension

The masterplan proposes to expand on the exsting playground infrastructure to create additional play value for the community and seasonal visitors. An extension with a variety of challenging play elements and areas for multiple different age groups could provide exciting opportunities for running, jumping, climbing, hanging, swinging, spinning, sliding, solving problems, playing games and provide many other challenging play options and modalities!
