


# TRUNDLE, NSW SKATEPARK CONSULTATION REPORT.


# 1. Age

## 2. Ride


It's apparent the majority of users ride Scooters and BMX but there is still a notable presence of skateboard riders.






#### 3. Skill Level

#### 4. Basic Obstacle








#### 5. Advanced Obstacle








## 6. Ramp

## 9. Concept Breif

Trundle having no pre-existing skate park or skate park history requires a brand new facility, most often a new facility is constructed in concrete due to the fact that there are no restrictions of what obstacles can be constructed. However concrete skate parks are constructed at a premium cost. Not ultimately knowing the communities wants and needs in a skate park our initial concepts reflected this build method leaving the door wide open for what every they came up with. However the nature of an In-Stu concrete build method is also a permanent option that was noted doesn't complement best the current site and community And we agree that a modular build will be most effective for the new proposed skate park in Trundle, this will offer additional options like;

- More skateable area and equipment.
- Council can save cost by constructing concrete pad in house.
- Obstacles can be relocated or swapped with other modular equipment in the region.
- Concrete pad can be used as a multi-sport court if ramps where ever to be taken away or sold

Our new concept now incorporates;

A Rollover being the highest identified Basic Obstacle.

All but any banked walls, covering 94% of Advanced Obstacle

A Half Pipe and tabletop, covering the 2 most desired obstacles for the Ramp Options. We feel we have hit the nail on the head with integrating all requested obstacles to suit Trundle's site and user group.

Your revised concept has been created taking into account the current site conditions, the integration of identified obstacles from community consultation, budget and site restrictions, current skate park trends, user group abilities and preferred riding equipment.
