

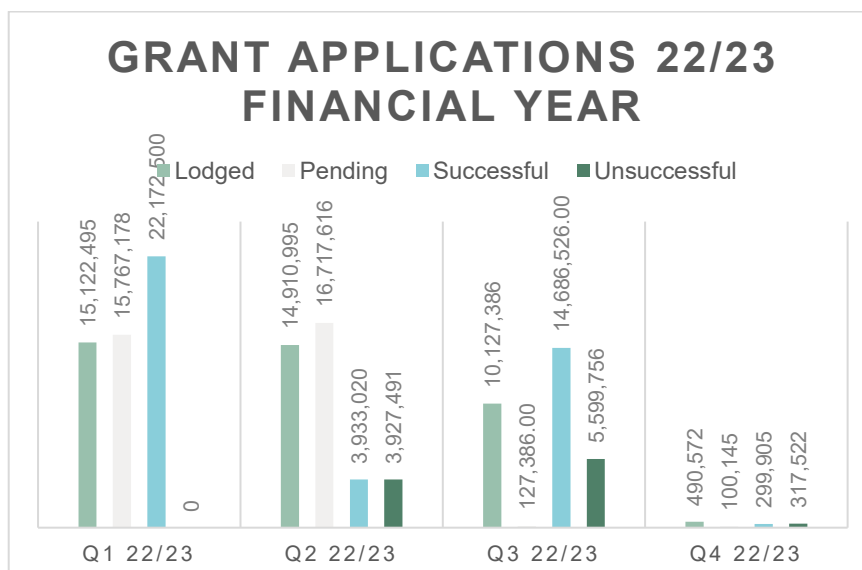
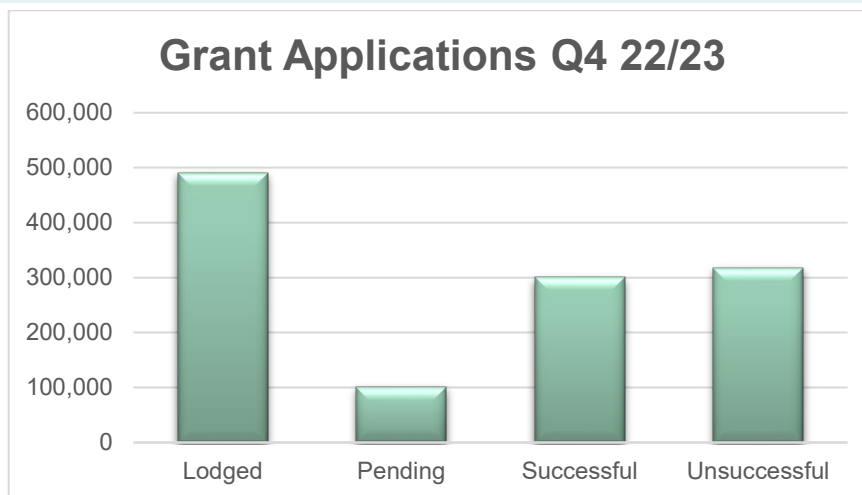

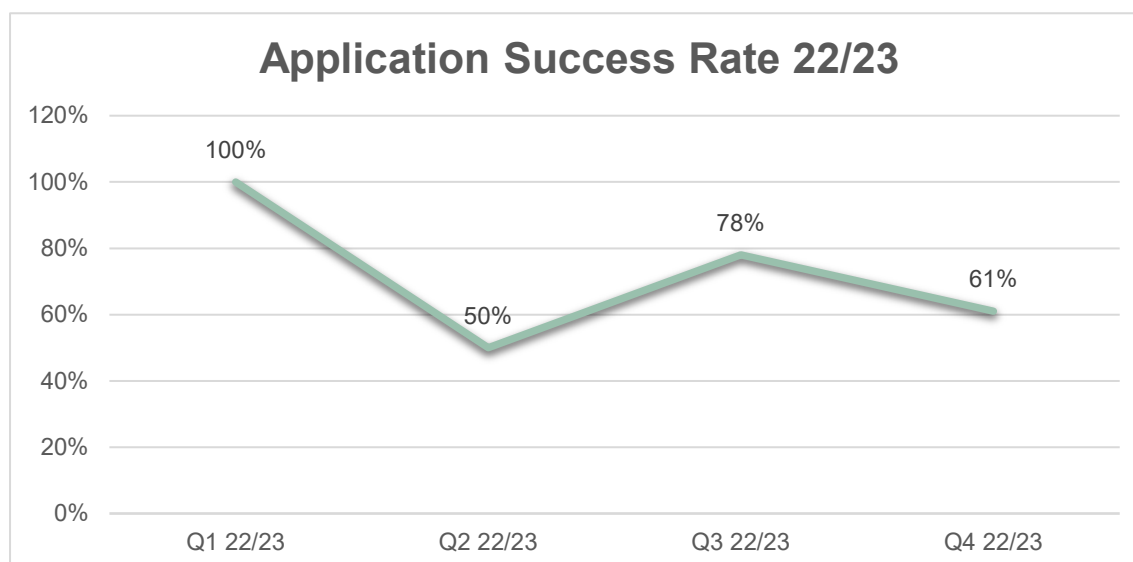

- 44 grant submissions were lodged worth approximately \$490,572.

5. Outcomes and benefits of successful applications

Community Grants dominated the grants sector over the past quarter:

- \$11,184 from the Safe Shooting Program for Parkes Sporting Shooters Association to purchase a new clay target thrower.
- \$8,000 from the Northparkes Community Investment Program to the Marimba Troupe.
- \$3,000 from the PSC Cultural Grant program to Parkes School of Dance to host a Ready to Rock 'n Roll workshop for the community with the Sydney Swing Katz.
- \$500 from the Arts OutWest Micro Grants to Parkes Craft Corner to host its annual Knit and Natter Day.
