Executive Summary

This report recommends that Parkes Shire Council ("Council") approve a request from the Cookamidgera Community Consultative Committee to use funds from the Cookamidgera Town Improvement Fund to purchase pest control for their Hall.

Background Information

Council is guided by the advice provided by the various Community Consultative Committees ("CCC") in determining the most appropriate projects to be included in their Town Improvement Allocations however, the final decision concerning the expenditure of the funds remains with Council.

Mr Bob Haddin of the Cookamidgera CCC advised that the recent mice infestation in the Shire has left Cookamidgera Hall in a compromised state. For the safety of the public, the Cookamidgera Trust is requesting release of TI funds in the amount of \$325.54 (GST Inclusive) for purchase of Surefire Rodent Stations and Surefire Bromo Blocks from AgriWest, Parkes.

Due to Cookamidgera Trust's AGM being held in the Hall on 2 August, 2022, there is some urgency for this approval.

Budget & Financial Aspects
