

Peak Hill Waste & Recycling Transfer Station Disposal Charges - 2023-24

Peak Hill Waste & Recycling Transfer Station is a modern transfer station delivering improved customer safety and sustainability outcomes in terms of operating efficiency, worker safety and environmental performance.

Waste disposal charges apply for waste loads to sustain the waste and recyclable management and disposal techniques in place, reducing the amount of waste ending up in landfill.

Peak Hill Waste & Recycling Transfer Station Disposal Charges Guide

Below is a guide to assist residents to determine what charges will be charged when disposing of waste at the Peak Hill Waste & Recycling Transfer Station. Domestic or household type recycling is free.

| Waste Bin - per 240 litre bin | \$4.80 | \$3.00 | n/a | n/a |
| Small Load - up to an average sedan boot or half a small trailer, approximately 0.5m³. | \$11.30 | \$7.60 | n/a | n/a |
| Medium Load - up to approximately 1m³. This may be a full normal sized single axel trailer body or a full utility tray. | \$19.10 | \$14.60 | n/a | n/a |
| Large Load - any volume larger than 1m³ but less than 1.5m³. This includes larger trailers. | \$43.80 | \$31.80 | n/a | n/a |

General and Domestic Mixed Waste

- Waste from households (other than garden organics).
- Green and Woody Timber Waste
 - Garden plants, lawn clippings, tree branches and trunks (does not include grains, hay, pallets, or packaging).
- Commercial and Industrial Waste
 - NOT ACCEPTED
- Construction and Demolition Waste
 - NOT ACCEPTED

Rethink Waste: Reduce, Reuse, Recycle

By re-thinking the way you dispose of waste materials you can help reduce the amount of rubbish that ends up in landfill. You can also reduce the amount you pay to dispose of a load by separating different waste materials. Place your green waste and recyclables into separate bins or loads to avoid them being categorised as mixed waste, which incurs a higher charge.

- Cover your load.
- Build specific loads such as green waste to qualify for cheaper rates. No charge will apply to separated recyclables.
- Take advantage of the 3 Bin Household Collection system (where available).
